How to Register

Registrations for our leagues are accepted online, by phone, and on printed registration forms. To sign up online, visit www.columbuseventcenter.com/register and complete the online registration form. Printable registration forms can also be found on our website, or at the rink. Forms can also be mailed by request. Register by phone by calling (402) 562-5663.

Basic Information:

- League games are played on Monday evenings.
- Leagues are open to boys and girls 5 & older, regardless of skill level or prior experience.
- Age is determined as of July 31, 2017.
- Prior hockey experience is NOT required to play.
- Everyone who registers gets to play, and all players will see equal playing time.
- Roller hockey is a fun, exciting sport. The action is contained within our hockey rink, which features dasher boards and tempered glass. Our Sport Court flooring resembles an ice surface.
- Substitutions are done "on the fly," which means players can be changed during play.
- Good sportsmanship is a big part of our leagues.

Cost / Fees:

- Players 7 years of age and older: \$45/player
- Players 6 years of age and younger: \$30/player
- There are no additional fees to participate in our leagues. We are no longer requiring an additional deposit payment for use of our jerseys.
- Financial assistance may be available from area agencies for those who qualify. Payment plan options may also exist (contact us for details).
- We will do what we can to make sure that all players can participate regardless of their financial situation at home.

Required Equipment:

- Columbus Event Center will provide most required equipment each week at no charge to our hockey participants (helmet, stick, gloves, shinguards)
- Players are responsible for providing their own skates, as well as additional suggested equipment (mouthguard, elbow pads, protective cup, etc)
- New players receive \$20 credit towards a new pair of skates purchased through our rink.
- Jerseys are provided by Columbus Event Center at no cost to our participants (youth divisions).
- Pants or shorts may be worn during league play.

Hockey Jerseys:

- Columbus Event Center will provide each player their own jersey to use for the season.
- The jerseys are the property of Columbus Event Center, and must be returned immediately following the final game of the season.
- Any jersey not returned by the final game of the season will be replaced at the expense of the league participant.
- Lost or damaged jerseys will also be replaced at the expense of the league participant.
- Please help us keep our jerseys clean and in good condition to keep costs down, and to ensure that they will be available for future seasons.
- We are no longer charging an additional fee or deposit for the use of the jerseys.
